Flu Response The Faith Team is recommending to us the following changes in our worship together.

1) Continue the exchange of "Peace" and respect the wishes of folks who will use another gesture, (head nod, wave, smile) rather than shaking hands.

2) Discontinue intinction or dipping the wafer into to communion cup and use pouring into all glasses instead.

3) Ask the Pastors to refrain from shaking hands at the end of worship.

4) Have Hand Sanitizer Pump bottles at the entrance doors of church.

5) Ask communion assistants to wash their hands before worship.

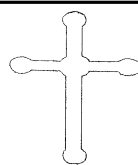
